Points of Emphasis for 2016

On- and Off-Campus Housing

We have beds for 18 girls and 18 boys in the dormitory. However, the Lord has blessed us with almost 60 students requiring boarding. Some students will live in a homestay (local family). We will be housing girls in a house one block outside our back gate. And finally, some boys will be in one of our on-campus apartments. In all boarding situations, students will have regular supervision, will follow the dorm handbook, and will be cared for as they were our own children. If you haven't already, you may receive a call from me to discuss your child's housing.

Dorm Check-in

The dormitory will be open at 6:00 pm on August 7th for those attending football and volleyball pre-season camps. Note: An evening meal will not be provided that night. All other students may move in on Sunday, August 14th. They may check in between 1:00-3:30 pm, then again following the **Opening Service** which begins at 4:00.

When reading through the handbook this summer, please take special note of the guidelines for arriving and departing the dorms this summer and vacations throughout the school year. We kindly ask for you to follow these guidelines when planning your children's travel.
